Why?

Romans 12:2 Do not become like the people who belong to this world. But let God completely change the way that you think, so that you live differently. Then you will understand what God wants you to do. You will know what is good. You will know what pleases God. You will know what is completely right.

Phil 4:8-9

Now my friends, I want to say this to you. Fill your minds with thoughts about good things. Think about things that are true, clean, right and lovely. Always think about things which people know are very good. 9 Remember what I have taught you. Remember the message that you heard from me. Remember what you saw when I lived among you. You also must do those same things. God is the one who gives us peace in our minds. He will be with you.

How can a young man live a pure life? He must be careful to obey your message. I bring all my thoughts to you. Do not let me turn away from your commands. I always keep your message in my mind, so that I do not do anything bad against you.

How?

- Start small – one verse a week

- Test yourself
- Review every day for a week and then once a week
